## ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES

**Zip Line and Rock Walls** require closed toed shoes. Must be at least 4 years old and must fit properly in a harness to participate.

Your journey begins as you climb the stairs to the top of the 40' Zip Line Tower. Once our facilitators securely clip you in, you can step off the platform and take an exhilarating ride down our 300' Zip Line. After your zip or as an alternative to zipping you can climb the rock wall on the outside of the zip tower! Your challenge is completely your choice!

**Ridge Camp Adventure Course** requires closed-toed shoes. Must be at least 11 years old and must fit properly in a harness to participate.

Your Ridge Camp experience will start on our low practice course just a few feet off the ground. Then you will ascend our 50 foot high static challenge course. Once in the air you will work through the static circuit course ending with the thrill of coming down through a leap of faith.

**Please note the following:** Do not participate if you weigh over 250lbs, are experiencing back, neck or shoulder problems, have a heart condition, high blood pressure, recent severe injury or surgery.



# SEYMOUR MARINE DISCOVERY CENTER\*\*

The Seymour Marine Discovery Center offers hands-on immersion into the world of ocean exploration and discovery. In our 20,000-square-foot visitor center, guests can touch a shark, explore the latest discoveries in ocean science, and take in the spectacular Monterey Bay, which has been called the “Serengeti of the sea” for its incredible diversity of marine life. Sign ups includes a 1pm admission and a 30 minute tour at 2:45, 3:15, or 3:45.

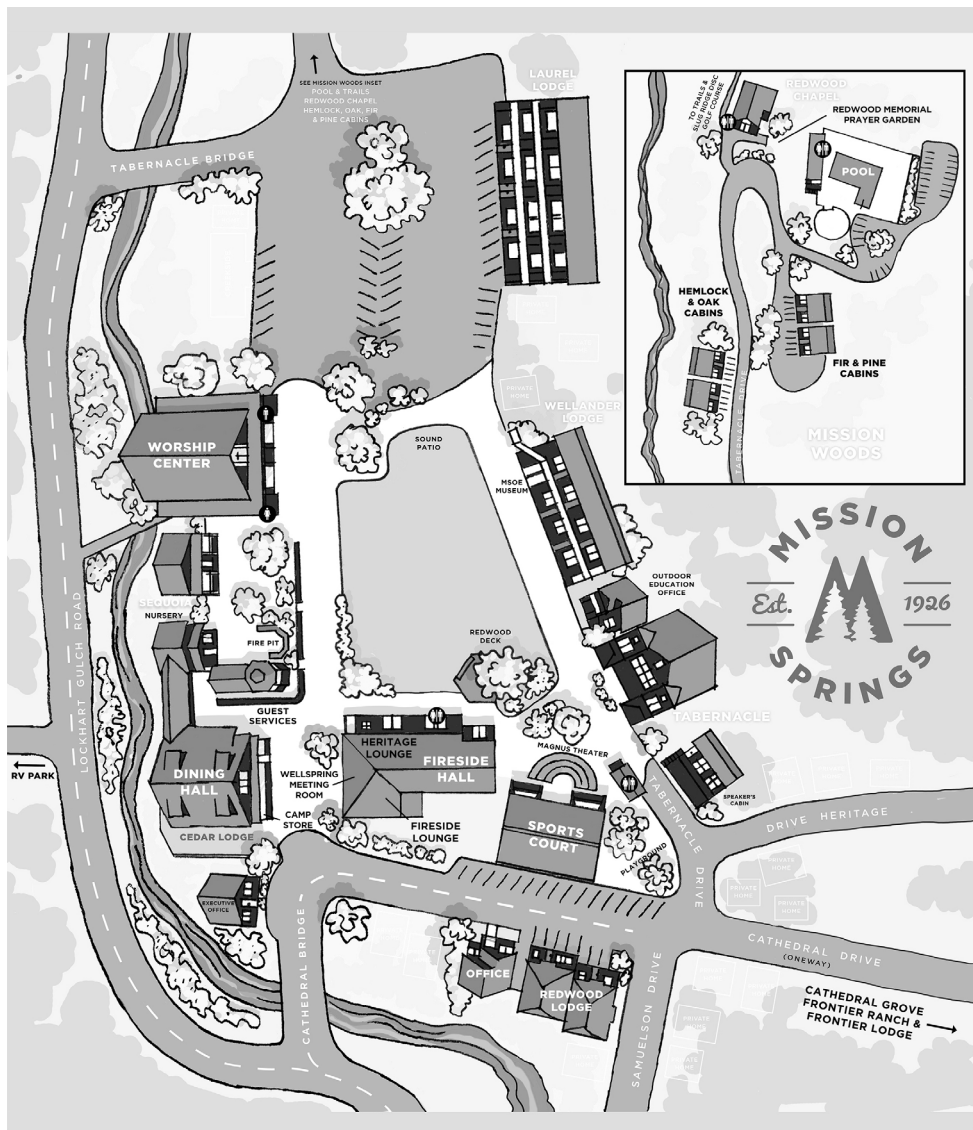
