### Phone Messages

All incoming phone messages for our guests will be given to your group leader to pass on to you.

### Late Night Needs

Our night host will be on duty until midnight every evening. If you have a problem or need and cannot locate our night host, contact your group leader.

### Noise Curfew

Mission Springs abides by our Santa Cruz County Noise Ordinance which is 10:00 pm to 8:00 am for amplified music and any loud noise. Please be respectful of those trying to sleep. We also ask that when using portable devices, please use headphones or ear-buds out of respect for others.

### First Aid & Emergencies

Simple first aid supplies may be found in the office or kitchen. Professional medical care is just five minutes away at Santa Cruz Medical Clinic in Scotts Valley **831-458-6335**. If someone is severely injured, please call 911 immediately. Let the office or night host know that you dialed 911 and give them the location of the injured person.

### WiFi

Wireless internet can be found in the main mall area. No password needed.

## Bikes, Scooters & Skateboards

While bikes, scooters, and roller-blades are okay at Mission Springs, we need to keep the mall area from the Worship Center past the Dining Room clear for strolling and socializing. Parents should help their children be sensitive to the safety of others and to avoid riding in heavy traffic areas. The basketball courts should also be clear when people are playing.

**Skateboards are not allowed on sidewalks or in the mall area.**



## Fires & Earthquakes

Fire extinguishers are located in every building. In case of an earthquake, we ask that all guests meet in the central lawn area in front of the Worship Center.

## Maps

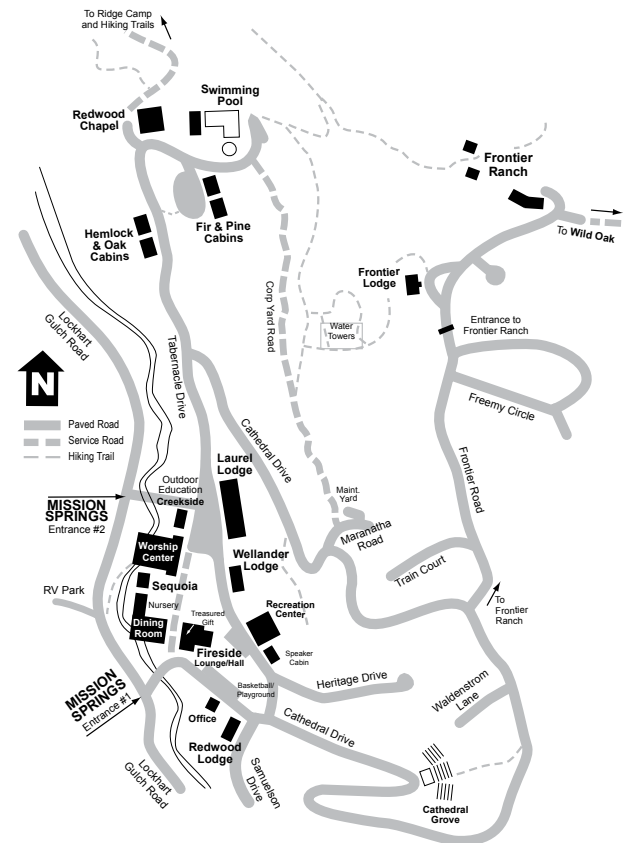
Maps of our facilities, grounds, and hiking trails are available in the office. You will also find maps of the Scotts Valley area featuring stores and services.

### Directions to Mission Springs

#### From San Jose:

- Take Hwy 17 south to the Mt. Hermon Road exit
- Turn right onto Mt. Hermon Road
- Go through Scotts Valley
- Turn right onto Lockhart Gulch Road
- Keep left at the fork and follow to 1050 Lockhart Gulch Road

#### From Santa Cruz:

- Take Hwy 17 north to Scotts Valley
- Take the Mt. Hermon Road exit
- Go through Scotts Valley
- Turn right onto Lockhart Gulch Road
- Keep left at the fork and follow to 1050 Lockhart Gulch Road
